The task is to write a monologue about a social issue. See below for details:

Choose a Social Issue:

Select a topic that resonates with you or that you'd like to explore. Examples include:

Bullying or peer pressure

Racism or discrimination

Mental health and stigma

Poverty or homelessness

Gender identity or inequality

Climate change and activism

Immigration or cultural identity

Create a Character:

Invent a character who is directly affected by or involved in the issue.

Consider their age, background, beliefs, and how the issue impacts their daily life.

Write a Monologue (1 minute in length):

Speak from the character's point of view.

Show their emotional journey—confusion, anger, hope, fear, courage, etc.

Use expressive language and include stage directions if needed.
