Year 10 into Year 11 Philosophy and Ethics Summer Homework 2025

When you come back in September you will be finishing the GCSE content by looking at your last two ethical themes – Theme B: Religion and Life, and Theme D: Religion, Peace and War. This homework is about consolidating what you have already covered in Ethics, and about preparing for what comes next. You will need to bring **all** tasks in for review with your teacher on the first lesson back in September:

Task 1:

Ethical Summary Pages. You need to complete a summary page / sheet / revision resource for the 2 ethical themes that you have completed already (Religion, Crime and Punishment and Human Relationships) as well as Christian Beliefs / Practices and Islamic Belief / Practices. This was part of your Golden Ticket work, however you might want to edit these and add to them following your PPEs. Each sheet should contain:

- 1. Key words from the topic
- 2. Different views that Christians and Muslims have
- 3. Quotes / references to the Bible / Qur'an

Remember to use the revision guides to help you and your PLCs. You can find all of this revision information on Teams – take a look and make sure you can access everything you need before the Summer Holiday's.

Task 2: Religion and Life / War and Peace Research

Create 2 A3 collages of everything you can find on Religion and Life / War and Peace. These should contain newspaper stories, clippings, images, events, people, statistics, examples etc.

Religion and Life includes: Abortion, Euthanasia, Contraception, Animal Testing, Animal Eating, Origins of the Universe, Origins of Life

Religion, Peace and war includes: Reasons for war, examples of war, nuclear war, weapons, prisoners of war, Holy War, Jihad

All homework will be reviewed in your first lesson of Year 11 – make sure that you bring it in – this will set you up ready for the final topic and make revision in the Summer so much easier!
